CERTIFICATION OF INABILITY TO OPERATE DUE TO LACK OF QUORUM

In accordance with Executive Order JBE 2020-30, issued by Governor John Bel Edwards on March 16, 2020, this notice shall serve as a certification of the inability of the Louisiana Board of Examiners of Certified Shorthand Reporters to otherwise operate in accordance with Louisiana Open Meetings Law due to a lack of a quorum as a result of the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency and the measures put in place to protect the health and safety of the public.

Accordingly, as attested to below, Vincent Borrello, Jr., Secretary of the Louisiana Board of Examiners of Certified Shorthand Reporters, has conferred with the members of the Board and confirmed their inability to attend a meeting in public in adherence with the measures in place under the direction and guidance from the White House, the Centers for Disease Control, and state health officials.
